



## 1429 Mfg. to make Las Vegas debut

ANNAPOLIS, Md. - Occasional furniture resource **1429 Mfg**, looks to expand its customer base through showing at **Las Vegas Market** for the first time at the Jan. 28-Feb. 1 winter 2018 show.

Specializing in infusing artwork on solid wood furniture, 1429 Mfg. began in April 2015 with a debut exhibition at **High Point Market**.

“Our unique construction process has attracted many designers and specifiers especially in the hospitality and contract field,” said Cynthia Gross, who co-founded 1429 Mfg. with fellow Annapolis native Bridgette Hamilton. “We know there’s untapped potential on the West Coast with the booming commercial market that we can reach out to with our Vegas market launch.”

Instead of using particle board or wood veneers, 1429 Mfg. sources different types of wood to serve as the canvas on which different patterns get infused directly onto the wood surface. Creating furniture from solid wood allows for increased durability of the product and structural integrity that can support large scale frames.

The occasional manufacturer will showcase its bestselling products at Las Vegas Market in P2-5002. Those include the Vera cocktail table, Weston modular cabinets, the Payton console, Carrington accent table and more.

“Our product line currently consists of all types of tables and cabinets but with our infusion technology, we can expand to wall art, accessories, and even upholstery,” said Hamilton. “We can also customize any of our existing styles with any artwork the designer provides, so while we may only be showing a specific number of products, the possibilities are limitless because of all the different artwork options.”

Retail prices range from \$1,495 to \$4,020 for featured products. All goods are designed in-house and sourced from four domestic manufacturing partners.
