The Coastal Collection is a series of pieces designed to celebrate the casual yet sophisticated lifestyle of seaside communities. Clean modern lines crafted with weathered woods and natural stones whisper the mood of soft breezes, warm sand, and gentle waves.



The Curves Occasional Chair from the Coastal Collection is a captivating example of how design can shape and serve as a foundational element for emotionally intelligent environments. The chair employs GEOMETRY defined by elegant curves that evoke a feeling of comfort, unity and harmony. The deliberate incorporation of curves in the design subtly creates an atmosphere of balance and tranquility.

The very materials of our furnishings whisper their own stories of well-being. Imagine running your hand along the smooth, warm surface of a wooden table, feeling an inexplicable sense of calm wash over you. This isn't just imagination at work. A groundbreaking study by the University of British Columbia revealed that the presence of wood in interiors actually reduced sympathetic nervous system activation, leading to lower stress levels. It's as if the very essence of the forest has been distilled into these wooden elements, bringing a piece of nature's serenity into our indoor spaces.

THE GIASONE COLLECTION

This collection is inspired by the ancient Greek myth about Giasone (Jason) who seeks the Golden Fleece, the magical artifact with powerful healing abilities. Our collection is a curated series of art and sculpture. Beyond providing drama and color to a space, these pieces are specifically offered with the intent of sharing contemplative and life enriching experiences of peace, tranquility and harmony.



Within the BIOMORPHIC FORM of the NEBULA LIGHT FIXTURE, lies a gentle reminder that we are interconnected with nature drawing upon its inherent healing properties. Nebulas is entirely handcrafted of Banaca, a fiber that is from the Phillipines, and woven by a community of weavers in the province of Bicol. The Nebula fixture acts as a conduit to nature's calming influences nurturing both the body and mind.
