Complementing the new tabletop collection is the Hornbill Garden pillow. It features a charismatic hornbill on one side, a symbol of fortune, prosperity, and community, along with a hoopoe bird and lily flower on the other side, an intricate design that is inspired by traditional Zulu beadwork. Available in three materials, cotton, velvet, or silk, in Ardmore’s signature Stone colorway, the two-sided pillow offers colorful versatility that depicts lively African landscapes.
