### Caracole Unveils New Collections with Claudio Bellini Studio at High Point Market

**HIGH POINT, NC | April 2025** — Caracole debuts two new collections designed by internationally celebrated designer Claudio Bellini, marking a milestone in the brand's evolution and reinforcing its commitment to design that enhances everyday emotional experiences. The collections, Fleur and Overlap, will be unveiled at High Point Market (April 24–30) at Caracole's showroom located at 122-C North Hamilton Street.

Born from a shared creative philosophy, the partnership between Caracole and Claudio Bellini Studio reflects a unified vision: design as a lifestyle, not just an object. Both parties believe that beauty at home should be deeply felt — not only seen — and that each piece of furniture should elevate comfort, expression, and joy.

This collaboration is centered on creating soulful environments that promote self-care and quiet moments of luxury. Rather than designing mere objects, Bellini and Caracole envision furniture as a medium for landscapes and emotions — an approach that blends beauty with meaningful living.

The Fleur Collection embodies refined softness — with sweeping curves, tailored finishes, and premium materials like flamed Canaletto walnut and ivory mohair. Inspired by nature and emotion, Fleur transforms organic forms into a poetic, harmonious aesthetic for dining, living and bedroom spaces.

In contrast, the Overlap Collection explores sculptural form and tactile contrast. Bold yet serene, it celebrates the raw beauty of natural stones like Nero Marquina and travertine, softened by layered textures and gold-accented details. Together, the two collections express a fluid balance between femininity and structure, sentiment and strength.

Over the course of his long career, he has received multiple awards and prestigious accolades, including the Red Dot, IF, and Good Design awards.

In 2024, driven by his cosmopolitan vision and design research across various fields, he strengthened his studio's presence as a creative hub on the global design scene with the foundation of CLAUDIO BELLINI Design Group.

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
