John-Richard Advances Sustainability with Major Renewable Energy Project at Vietnam Facility

HIGH POINT, NC, [April 2025] – John-Richard is enhancing its sustainability efforts through a new solar energy initiative at its dedicated, LEED-certified manufacturing facility in Phu Tan Industrial Park, Binh Duong Province, Vietnam. Purpose-built in partnership with Fraser Property Vietnam, this factory is exclusively operated by John-Richard and reflects a long-term investment in responsible production practices.

The project will span two of the facility's four buildings, featuring solar panels and advanced monitoring technologies. Once online, the system will generate approximately 700,000 kWh of clean energy annually—covering about 70% of the facility's total electricity needs.

“Our factory was designed with sustainability in mind from the beginning,” said Antony Maitland Smith, General Manager of John-Richard Vietnam. “Partnering again with Fraser Property Vietnam strengthens our shared mission to implement sustainable practices across all operations.”

This initiative builds on John-Richard's broader environmental programs, including VOC capture, waste stream elimination, and comprehensive recycling—reinforcing the company's commitment to long-term ecological impact and community responsibility.
